### SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC LANDS, WATERS STRONGER **THAN EVER** Last month, the University of Montana released their <u>biannual public lands survey</u>. This

survey confirmed what we already know — Montanans love our public lands and waters and

want to protect them and the access to them for future generations. Access to public lands and water is the top aspect Montana voters

want to retain for future generations. "Access to public lands,



Team MCV is tirelessly advocating for better public lands protections. These are protections we know to be bipartisan issues with strong public support, such as:

**-The Smith River:** 73% support a public process to decide whether to mine copper on public lands near the headwaters of the Smith River (sign the petition HERE to ask the Forest Service to put a stop to this); **-BLM Public Lands Rule:** 70% support the new Bureau of Land Management Public Lands

Rule that puts conservation on par with other uses of public lands (reach out to MCV's Program Director, Kearstyn Cook at Kearstyn@mtvoters.org to sign an opinion piece in support); **-BCSA:** 85% support the Blackfoot Clearwater Stewardship Act - a bill made for Montanans by Montanans to protect the Blackfoot River headwaters and the communities in the area






